Upcoming public meeting on the *Regulatory Oversight Report on the Use of Nuclear Substances in Canada: 2021*

In November 2022, the [Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission](#) (CNSC) will hold a public meeting where CNSC staff will present the *Regulatory Oversight Report on the Use of Nuclear Substances in Canada: 2021* (ROR).

The ROR provides CNSC staff's assessment of the safety performance of licensees in the medical, industrial, academic and research, and commercial sectors that used nuclear substances in Canada in 2021.

Date: November 2–3, 2022
Place: To be determined (Ottawa, Ontario, and/or virtually)
Time: As set by the agenda published prior to the meeting date

The public meeting will be webcast live and available on the CNSC website at nuclearsafety.gc.ca.

In advance of the public meeting, the CNSC is making available up to **\$7,500** in funding through its [Participant Funding Program](#) (PFP). The purpose of the funding is to assist Indigenous Nations and communities, members of the public and stakeholders in reviewing CNSC staff's ROR and participating in the Commission meeting process by providing topic-specific written submissions to the Commission. Applications for participant funding must clearly demonstrate how the proposed intervention will provide the Commission with information directly relating to the ROR or safety performance of nuclear substances licensees during 2021. Please note that the \$7,500 will be disbursed among all successful applicants. The deadline for submitting a completed participant funding application form to the CNSC is **May 27, 2022**.

The ROR will be available for review on the CNSC website, or on request to the Registry, after **August 19, 2022**.

Persons who have an interest or expertise in this matter are invited to comment, in writing, on the ROR by **October 3, 2022** using the [online request form](#), [by email](#), or the contact information below. The submission must include your name, address, telephone number and email address. In addition, the CNSC will allow Indigenous intervenors the opportunity to make oral presentations in the spirit of reconciliation and in recognition of the Indigenous oral tradition for

sharing knowledge. Oral presentations will be conducted remotely. **The request to intervene must include the following information:**

- A written submission of the comments to be presented to the Commission
- A statement setting out whether the requester wishes to intervene by way of written submission only or by way of written submission and oral presentation
- The requester's name, address, telephone number and email address

All submissions will be available for download on the CNSC website or on request to the Registry. Personal information, such as address and telephone number, is essential for linking the submission to its author. If you wish to ensure the confidentiality of your personal information, please submit it on a separate page.
