



Revised Notice of Hearing

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a hearing in August 2017 to consider a request from Hydro-Québec to modify the financial guarantee agreement for its Gentilly-2 nuclear facility and radioactive waste management facilities. The hearing to consider Hydro-Québec's application had originally been scheduled for July 2017, but was rescheduled to August 2017 to allow members of the public to comment on the matter.

Changes have been requested to reflect the closing and future decommissioning of the Gentilly-2 facility and Hydro-Québec's decision to continue the facility's dormancy phase over several years.

Pursuant to rule 3 of the *Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission Rules of Procedure* (the Rules), the Commission has decided to vary the Rules and to consider written submissions from Hydro-Québec and CNSC staff, as well as written interventions from members of the public. A panel of the Commission will then deliberate and render a decision on Hydro-Québec's application.

Pursuant to rule 19 of the Rules, members of the public who have an interest or expertise in this matter or information that may be useful to the Commission in coming to a decision are invited to comment, in writing, on Hydro-Québec's application. Requests to intervene must be filed with the Commission Secretariat by **August 18, 2017** using the [online request form](#) or following the coordinates below. **The request to intervene must include the following information:**

- a written submission of the comments to be presented to the Commission
- the requester's name, address and telephone number

All submissions are available to the public on request to the Secretariat. Personal information, such as address and telephone numbers, is essential for linking the submission to its author. If you wish to ensure the confidentiality of your personal information, please submit it on a separate page.

The hearing submissions are not available on the CNSC website and must be requested through the Secretariat at the coordinates below.

Following the deliberations and Commission decision on this matter, a *Record of Decision* will be published on the CNSC website at nuclearsafety.gc.ca and made available to the public on request.
