CNSC Staff Meeting with Curve Lake First Nation to Discuss the Ontario Ministry of Environment and Climate Change's Deloro site licence renewal

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) offered funding support, under its Participant Funding Program (PFP), for CNSC meetings on matters of regulatory interest and process, to facilitate a meeting on October 5, 2017 between Curve Lake First Nation and CNSC staff. The meeting was to discuss the Ontario Ministry of Environment and Climate Change's (MOECC's) Deloro site licence renewal, and to assist Curve Lake First Nation in submitting written comments to the Designated Officer of the Commission for the Deloro licence renewal.

The information gathered from the meeting will be included in CNSC staff's Designated Officer Document for the Deloro site licence renewal in order to bring any valuable information directly to the Designated Officer of the Commission. The deadline for submitting the PFP application to the CNSC was September 22, 2017.

## **Background**

PFP support for CNSC meetings on matters of regulatory interest was made available by the CNSC to:

- enhance Aboriginal and stakeholder participation in the CNSC's environmental assessment and licensing processes, and
- help stakeholders bring valuable information to the Commission.

A Funding Review Committee (FRC), independent from the CNSC, was established to review the funding application received by the CNSC's PFP Administrator, and to make recommendations on the allocation of funding to the applicant.

The FRC member was Mr. Bruce Young, retired Canadian Environmental Assessment Agency Director.

The CNSC received one funding application requesting \$9,750, and this was reviewed by the FRC.
